InterComfort™ PS+ Installation Instructions

InterComfort PS+ can be used with Interface GlasBac® and GlasBacRE or Graphlex® and Graphlar® backings for added underfoot comfort and sound reduction.

- Remove/smooth any sharp objects or projections from the surface of the slab to prevent puncturing or tearing the InterComfort PS+ sheet.
- 2. Sweep the slab to remove dust, debris and tacky adhesive residue.
 - * Sweep using a sweeping compound (do NOT use oil based or silicone based sweeping compounds) or vacuum with an industrial vacuum.
 - * Tacky adhesive residue must be removed or reduced and the residual encapsulated.
 - * Dry adhesive residue may remain on the surface if it is smooth, level and otherwise in compliance with Interface GlasBac and GlasBacRE or Graphlex and Graphlar modular carpet installation specifications.
- Spread a bead of pad adhesive in a serpentine pattern over the floor, as well as around the perimeter and at the seams. Roll out a 20-30' section of the

- InterComfort pad fuzzy side down (smooth side up.)
- 4. Lay the InterComfort PS+ pad in the wet adhesive rough side down, making sure to keep the material flat to the floor (no wrinkles). The smooth side should be facing upward.
- Roll out the next row in the same manner, butting tightly to the previous roll. **Do not** overlap. Cutouts around columns, utilities, etc., should be about 1/4 inch.
- 6. Smooth out pockets of trapped air.
- 7. Continue laying rows of InterComfort PS+ until the desired coverage is achieved.
- 8. Protect from other trades.
- 9. Once the InterComfort PS+ is installed, installation of the modular carpet follows the standard installation instructions for Interface GlasBac and GlasBacRE or Graphlex and Graphlar backed modular carpet using the Interface TacTiles® installation system. Because the TacTiles connectors are being used over the InterComfort PS+, be sure to cut the tiles net to the wall.
